

Fresh Water Well for the Abayudaya Jews of Uganda

In embracing the value, Klal Yisrael, 'all Israel,' in 2015 Ahavas Sholom built a sister Synagogue relationship with Namatumba Synagogue and embarked on raising funds for the projects identified as critical to the community by Namatumba leadership.

Last year, we focused on education. During Yom Kippur of 2015 the Congregation raised \$10,080 for Namatumba to be able to hire 12 teachers for one year for the school.

This year, we would like to work to fulfill a critical health need identified by leadership in Namatumba – access to fresh water. We will focus initially on raising funds for **one** borehole in order to provide a freshwater supply. If goal is reached, **one** freshwater well borehole will be completed. If goal is surpassed and double the goal is raised, the Congregation will fund **two** boreholes.

Ahavas Sholom, a 501c3, will pay funds directly to an engineer with previous experience drilling boreholes in the community.



Goal: \$15,000
